Highlights from Budget 2010

Budget 2010 was passed recently and was one of the major accomplishments of this Parliamentary session. It completes the funding of Canada’s Economic Action Plan, which has helped Canada through the most difficult economic downturn since the 1930’s. It injects \$19 billion of new stimulus into our economy to create and protect jobs, secure Canada’s economic recovery, and sustain our global economic advantage. It will achieve this through:

- **Personal income tax relief (\$3.2 billion)** - adjustments to federal tax brackets; enhancing the Working Income Tax Benefit; higher child benefits for parents; lower taxes for low- and middle-income seniors.
- **Re-training and worker support (over \$4 billion)** - enhancing EI benefits; internships and skills development to help young workers find jobs.
- **Infrastructure (\$7.7 billion)** - modernizing Canada’s capital assets; stimulating the housing sector.
- **R & D (over \$1.9 billion)** - strengthening research capacity; expanding market access and competitiveness; improving commercialization.
- **Targeted support to industries and communities (\$2.2 billion)** - helping to create and maintain jobs in forestry, agriculture, small business, tourism, culture.
- **Strengthening Manufacturers** - making Canada a tariff-free zone for manufacturing inputs.
- **Supporting business** - establishing a Red Tape Reduction Panel to reduce paperwork.
