CPC Convention Outcomes

Your hard work bore fruit at the Convention!!!! Participants at the Guelph Policy and Constitution Development meeting in April raised topics which became co-sponsorships as other EDAs had already submitted policy resolutions on these topics. Policy resolutions co-sponsored by Guelph and which passed at the Convention with a considerable majority were: #1063-Getting Resources to Market, Policy #1257-China and Policy #1279-Child Protection. Additionally, participants from the April 8th meeting were instrumental in finalizing the wording of the successful Child Protection resolution.
